Classes Offered this Semester:

Spring 2017

CHIN 106:

Chinese Level II (4) MTWR 2-2:50

Students develop basic conversational skills and beginning proficiency in reading and writing Mandarin Chinese. Authentic linguistic and cultural contexts may include music, dance, Chinese philosophy, and the history of idioms.

CHIN 109:

Introduction to Chinese Studies (3) W 5-7:50

This course employs historical, philosophical, comparative, and interdisciplinary approaches to study Chinese cultures and societies in global and local contexts. *Taught in English.*

CHIN 207:

Chinese Level IV (4) MTWR 1-1:50

Intermediate Mandarin Chinese language and cultures. Authentic linguistic and cultural contexts. Compare and contrast cultural and ethnic groups in China, and Chinese and U.S. worldviews, religion, education, and economy.
