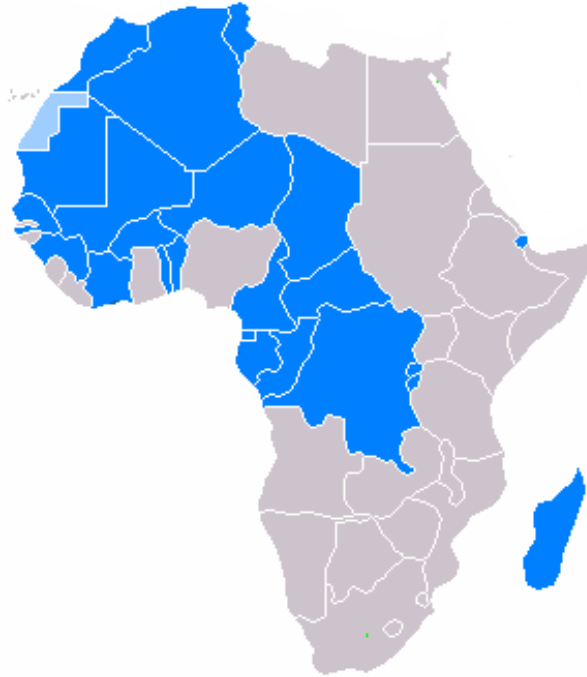

DESCRIPTION: To provide students a \$500 award to study in Francophone Africa for a minimum of an academic semester, or equivalent. First preference will be given to students participating in the HSU Department of World Languages and Cultures programs such as the Summer Semester in Senegal. Second preference will be given to students participating in other HSU and CSU system programs. The Fund is intended to support as many students as possible who are accepted to participate in these programs, regardless of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY: For students accepted to participate in an HSU-approved study abroad program during the 2017-18 Academic Year (includes summer of 2017). Preference will be given to students who have never participated in an academic program abroad. All HSU students in good standing may apply. Prior recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to reapply.
