Francophone African Studies Award



DESCRIPTION: To provide students two (2) \$1,000 awards to study in Francophone Africa for a minimum of an academic semester, or equivalent. First preference will be given to students participating in the HSU Department of World Languages and Cultures programs such as the Summer Semester in Senegal. Second preference will be given to students participating in other HSU and CSU system programs. The award is intended to support as many students as possible who are accepted to participate in these programs, regardless of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY: For students who have applied to or are planning to apply to an HSU-approved study abroad program in Francophone Africa during the 2021-2022 Academic Year (includes Summer of 2021). Preference will be given to students who have never participated in an academic program abroad. All HSU students in good standing may apply. Special consideration will be given to students with financial need. Prior recipients of this award are not eligible to reapply. Please note, if you are not accepted into a program, or elect not to go, you will forfeit the award money.
